

## **Harvest Times for Selected Fruit Cultivars in the Sacramento Valley Foothills**

The following information was provided by Janine Hasey, Farm Advisor UCCE Sutter-Yuba Counties, based on an 8-year old research plot in California's lower Sierra Nevada foothills at 600' elevation.

Janine also notes that Bing cherries in the Sacramento Valley ripen in late May-June.

### **Apple**

Fuji: Oct  
Gala: Aug  
Granny Smith: Oct  
Red Delicious: Mid-August - Sept.

### **Cherry**

Early Burlat: Late April - May  
Stella: May - June

### **Nectarine**

Fantasia : Mid-July - Mid Aug  
Flavortop: Mid-July - Mid Aug  
Summergrand: Mid-July - Mid Aug

### **Peach**

Nectar: July  
Fay Elberta: Late July - Aug  
Springcrest: Mid-June

### **Plum**

Elephant Heart: Mid-Aug - Sept  
Simka: Mid-Aug - Sept  
Santa Rosa: Mid-June - Mid-July
